Syllabus Extract

Assignment as Described in Syllabus: The Senior Project counts as 45% of your course grade. Students will select a topic to research or a project to develop that is of significance to the student's career or interests and is communication-based. The project should demonstrate the synthesis of communication coursework the student completed and will be supervised by a communication faculty member.

Upon completion, the project will be formally presented in various contexts to classmates, faculty (for evaluation leading to acceptance, revision, or rejection), and various audience members prior to graduation.

NOTE: Choose a project in an area of communication with which you are familiar and have taken coursework in to provide a foundation for your project.

The project components consist of the following:

- Complete Senior Project - Digital Copy [30%]
- 30-minute Presentation of Senior Project to the Department of Communication [15%]

NOTE: 20-minute formal presentation with 10 minute question/answer session with department faculty and audience members.
