4. Makes detailed, feasible recommendations based on the indigenous people's wishes and/or the NGO's mission, expertise, funds, and reach, and supports her recommendation with appropriate evidence (DGP 4, EC 3)
5. Accurately assesses both her written and spoken performance and provide evidence supporting her judgments (Analysis, 4)
6. Demonstrates a comprehensive analysis of her thinking about the issue(s) (DGP 4)
